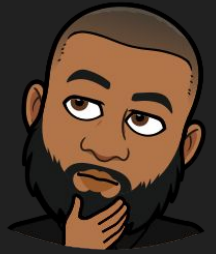

What you need to know

- All HMS students are able to attend at no cost.
- **Night Hawk is a mixture of academic and non-academic activities.**
- All programs are supervised and structured.
- **Night Hawk is not SACC**
 - Students only attend when they are interested in at least one activity taking place that day.
- Every student must be registered before attending.

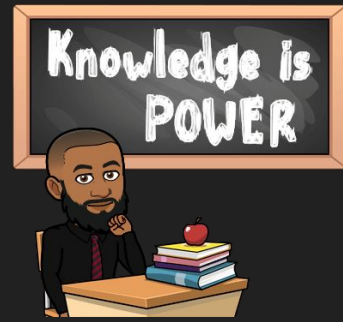


Expectations | Locations

- **Students will report directly to the cafeteria after school to check in and wait until they are dismissed.**
- **Students must be in a supervised activity *at all times*.**
 - Students who show up continuously late to after-school programs may have their after-school privileges taken away.
- **If students are not in an activity, they must leave the building.**
- **Students that leave the building cannot return for the day.**



Participating in Night Hawk



- Night Hawk is a **PRIVILEGE** to attend, not a right.
- **ACADEMICS COME FIRST!** If a staff member or parent requests that a student stay after-school due for academics, the student must attend the **Academic Support session** before participating in their activity of choice.
- Students will treat **EVERYONE** with respect during the day and after school. Bullying, name calling, play fighting, and disrespect will not be tolerated.



Night Hawk Daily Schedule

2:15 Sign -In @ the Cafeteria and get your Super Snack | Stay until Picked Up

2:45 Block 1 Begins

3:45 Dismissal from Block 1 | Transition (Block 2 or leave the building)

3:50 Arrival at Block 2 - Sign-In at location

4:50 Dismissal for Late Buses | Go To Kiss & Ride for pickup | Walk Home



Late Bus Days | Mondays - Thursdays

- **Students must attend blocks 1 and 2 in order to take the Late Bus.**
 - Walkers and other non-late bus riders have the option to leave after Block 1 during the transition time (3:45 - 3:50 PM)
- **Late bus numbers are different than regular buses (HILR-XX)**
- **Buses will leave HMS at 4:55PM.**



Non Late Bus Day | Fridays

Students are responsible for their own way home

- Walking
- Parent Pick Up
- Reston Teen Center (must be registered) or Other coordinated transportation.



For Your Information

Phones can be used appropriately during Night Hawk...

- Phones should be away during Blocks 1 & 2.
- You must have headphones if listening to any audio.
- Picture taking, including selfies and videos, is not allowed.
- Any misuse of phone privileges may result in “Away for the Day” during Night Hawk.

One you step outside of the school at dismissal, you cannot re-enter.

If you are not in school during the day, you cannot attend Night Hawk.

You cannot attend Night Hawk if you have In School Suspension that day.

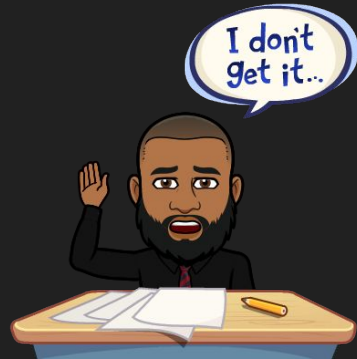
What's Next?
