NIGHT HAWK BASICS

- Night Hawk is not SACC.
 - Students are **not** required to participate daily, but they can if they would like to!
 - Students only stay after school on the day(s) that they are interested in the activities offered.
- There is no fee to attend Night Hawk and all current HMS students are welcome to attend.
- All activities are supervised by FCPS Employees at all times.
- Night Hawk provides academic support, builds social skills, and students can participate in fun activities. There is a mixture of diverse academic and non-academic activities.

- Encourage your student to get involved in as many activities as possible, including ones they have never done before.

- Activities will be changed (added/removed) as the year progresses.
- Due to limited space and resources, some activities may require try-outs.

DISMISSAL & LATE BUS INFORMATION

- Late Buses are available Monday - Thursday. Fridays are walking/ parent pick-up days.
- Late bus stops differ from regular stops. The Bus Number will begin with “HILR”.
- Students can be picked up at Kiss and Ride, which is located behind the school in the bus parking lot near Door 6. There are no pickups from the front door.

PARTICIPANT EXPECTATIONS

- Students must be in the cafeteria by 2:20 PM if they would like to stay after school that day.
- Students must sign in every day they stay after.
- Students must respect the building at all times. This includes helping keep the school clean.
- Students must respect everyone at all times.
- Students must keep all body parts to themselves at all times.
- Students must be at a supervised activity the entire time they are staying after school.
- During transitions, students must go directly to their next activity or leave the building.
- Deliveries are not allowed.

ACADEMIC POLICY

- Students with academic obligations must fulfill those prior to attending a non-academic activity.
- Students with Ds/Fs will need to get additional support from those teachers at least once a week in order to participate in other Night Hawk activities.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

- Students must be registered in order to attend.
- If a student is absent from school, they are not permitted to participate in Night Hawk that day.
- Students cannot leave the building and then return unless they are checked in by a parent/guardian.

BEHAVIORAL POLICY

- Students' behavior during the school day may impact their participation in Night Hawk.
- Night Hawk follows the HMS & FCPS behavioral guidelines. **Bullying and disrespect of any kind will not be tolerated in the after-school program.** Students who do not abide by the rules and regulations may lose after-school privileges.
- Loitering during Night Hawk activities will result in at least an automatic one week Night Hawk suspension.
- Fighting during Night Hawk will result in at least an automatic two week Night Hawk suspension along with possible in-school consequences.

PHONE POLICY

- Students are allowed to use their phones appropriately after school.
- Pictures, Videos, FaceTime, Calling & Texting aren't allowed.
- Students must watch appropriate media and wear headphones if listening to music/sound.
